## PROJECT OUTCOMES

### INCREASE STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

For 2020-21 school year, McLean Panorama Survey showed the campus outperformed the district in 3 key categories:

- Sense of Belonging (45%)
- Teacher Student Relationships (61%)
- Emotional Regulation (47%)

### INCREASE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

- 100% of campus has adopted choice boards
- Growth is strongest in 7th grade where choice boards were adopted
  - From Fall 2020 to Spring 2021, 7th Grade Math MAP Growth attainment increased by 10 points from 217 to 227
  - Average RIT scores increased from 5th grade level to on track at 7th grade level

### IMPROVE 7TH GRADE MATH ACHIEVEMENT

In the 2019-20 school year, McLean was ranked below six other campuses in Fort Worth ISD for relative 7th grade Math STAAR results

Now, in the 2020-21 school year, McLean is:

- 2nd in the district for 7th grade Math STAAR results
- And the performing traditional middle school in the district
