## STUDENT BLUEPRINT & STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

### Target Audience

Initial: 2nd Grade ESL Scholars  
Evolving: All K-6 Scholars

### Interventions

- Implemented TELPAS blueprint for student goal-setting
- Increased student success and capacity in classroom
- Created system to enhance student affirmation in small groups
- Developing campus-wide house system

## PROJECT OUTCOMES

### LEARNING BLUEPRINT IMPLEMENTATION

- Student interaction rates in small group instruction time increased
- Students able to articulate a goal for their listening and speaking
- No TELPAS data available due to COVID 19

### HOUSE SYSTEM INCREASES STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

The campus house system was a prototype developed to address the immediate needs of the campus, including student goal setting from the prior year. Strategies utilized included:

- Use of digital goal setting through MAP/NWEA testing
- Focus on two key TEKS in classroom
- House system as motivation & reward for all students

### INCREASE IN MAP GROWTH ATTAINMENT

From the Fall of 2020 to the Spring of 2021, students meeting their expected growth goals in MAP:

- 3rd Grade: Reading (+36%), Math (+36%)
- 4th Grade: Reading (no change), Math (+27%)
- 5th Grade: Reading (+27%), Math (+27%)
- 6th Grade: Reading (+22%), Math (+66%)
