PROJECT OUTCOMES

INCREASE PARENTAL ENGAGEMENT

By implementing parent town halls and increasing communication, Triumph saw:

- 97% average daily attendance rate, with virtual students attending at higher rates
- Re-enrollment coming into to the 2021-22 school year was at 83%
- Parent testimonials:
 - "I am so thankful for my scholar's teacher. She communicates with me daily and I see a big difference in my child this year, especially since coming back in person."
 - "I see my daughter's teacher making connections every day with the kids on Zoom, and she is always reaching out to parents with updates. I feel very involved in my child's education."

INCREASE ACHIEVEMENT

Though 50% of teachers did not meet goals set by network for Q4 and Q5, 100% of grade levels in both math and reading grew in MAP goal attainment

IMPROVE TEAM PROGRESS ON SEMESTER GOALS

The goal was to have 100% of teams reaching Phase 5 of the whole group professional development and coaching elements.

By the end of the year in 2020-21, several teams were in various phases of the process. The campus will prioritize joint observations and development plans for further impact.
